

Research Study for Children with Disruptive Behaviors

We are looking for families who have a child with disruptive behaviors to help us investigate a new treatment - called Regulation Focused Psychotherapy for Children (RFP-C) - for oppositional defiant disorder (ODD).



Is your child often argumentative? Does your child deliberately annoy others or blame them for his mistakes? Is your child often angry or irritable? Does your child often get in trouble at home and in school? Does your child lose his temper frequently?

If so, you may be eligible to participate in a trial of RFP-C. This therapy involves meeting with a therapist twice a week for 10 weeks. Treatment will be provided at no cost.

Qualifying children must be:

- Between the ages of 5 and 12
- Experiencing oppositional defiant disorder
- Fluent in English
- Not diagnosed with a developmental disorder

Interested caregivers and their child will meet with a research assistant to be interviewed and to complete five questionnaires to see if they are eligible.
